#### **CAUTION !**

This leaflet contains important instructions to be strictly complied with for the installation and maintenance of the Tenconi Insulated Joints.

- ➔ Do not install the Tenconi Insulated Joints if some of its components are damaged, lost or missing. Be sure to entrust the installation only to skilled personnel using the right equipment.
- → Be careful when handling the Tenconi Insulated Joints: they are heavy and can slip if placed on smooth, unsteady or inclined surfaces!
- → If a leak or failure is detected, the Tenconi Insulated Joints have to be replaced immediately!





## **Installation and handling Instructions**

It can be installed on site – or in workshop – using basic permanent way tools and skills. To avoid handling injuries or incorrect installation, only skilled and duly trained personnel has to be entrusted with the installation of the Tenconi insulated Joints.


If still in good conditions, properly maintained and cleaned, the Tenconi Insulated Joints can be disassembled and re-used. The TENCONI Joint is a precision system with bolts having a tight clearance in the rail web holes. These must be jig-drilled either in factory or on site.

On site power rail drills with appropriate templates suitable for drilling to the tolerances given in these instructions are available on the market.




 $C = 73 \pm 0.2 \text{ mm}$   $\emptyset = 25 \pm 0.2 \text{ mm}$ 

- c) Check that the gap between rail ends is correct (**4mm**) and the faces are parallel.
- d) Wire brush the fishing chambers on approximatly 600 mm on both rail ends.




## 3 JOINT ASSEMBLY

- a) Install the End Post (**pos 3**).
- b) Install one nut (**pos 6**) on each stud (**pos 5**).
- c) Install one insulated fishplate (**pos 1** or **pos 2**) taking care that the ribs are toward the rail web and that the writing TENCONI are positioned on the top side.
- d) Install two waherplates (**pos 4**) on that fishplate and insert the studs with the nuts using a light hammer.
- e) Install the second insulated fishplate (**pos 2** or **pos 1**) as in c).
- f) Install the two washerplates (**pos 4**) and the nuts (**pos 6**).



## 4 JOINT LOCKING

- a) Tighten all the nuts slightly.
- b) Tighten the nuts completely with a torque spanner in the sequence 2, 3, 1 and 4.
- c) The torque of **760Nm** shall be applied.
- d) Remove the excess plastic of the End Post from the running surface using a chisel or file.



#### **5 RETIGHTENING OF THE NUTS**

a) One month after installation the nuts must be retightened using the above indicated torque value.

#### **Maintenance Instructions**

The Tenconi Insulated Joints need to be regularly maintained and cleaned. In particular iron dust traces and other scraps left by trains on the rails can create conductivity between two rail ends, what would disable the operation of the insulated joints.

## 6 MAINTENANCE

- a) Maintenance is limited to periodical cleaning of the fishplate, particularly around the End Post area in order to avoid electric contacts between the two rails.
- b) Maintenance frequency depends on traffic and local environmental conditions.

#### 7 SPECIAL INSTRUCTION

a) During periods of cold weather the opening of the gap at the End Post may be observed. This event does not represent a failure of the joint, whose integrity and functionality are still guaranteed.
